## Just Say No! – To Phragmites Kayaks/Canoes Most Welcome

SRA needs volunteers help remove a patch of the invasive Phragmites plants that are strangling habitat along the Severn River.

This year's removal effort is on Plum Creek (see: <http://goo.gl/maps/oXkCZ>).

**Bring a kayak or canoe if you have one, and a friend or two!** Long clothing, water shoes or old sneakers are recommended.

SRA's Michael Robinson will lead volunteers by canoe/kayak into the headwaters of Plum Creek where you will encounter native cattails, cardinal flowers, and a rare stand of wild rice that still survives on Plum Creek. A previous phragmites removal effort enabled this important wildlife food source to flourish.
