SRA volunteers will use your boat to help develop our new shore inspection program to monitor compliance with Critical Area regulations. To this end, SRA needs a small boat that can get into the nooks and crannies of the Severn River Watershed to inspect and photograph existing shorelines.

SRA will also use your donated boat to take event photos to chronicle all the efforts our volunteers undertake to protect and enhance the river. SRA projects range from kayak tours through the Severn's headland creeks, to inspecting Critical Area buffer zones and planting oyster spat on the SRA sanctuary reef.

Donating your boat to SRA benefits not only the river, but also creates a tax deduction for you because SRA is a Section 501(c)(3) nonprofit.
