## Meet The Candidates – Environment Night A River Watch Forum

Should Anne Arundel County tackle stormwater pollution? Enforce Critical Areas rules? Repeal the rain tax? Our next County Executive will be a major participant and leader in making these million-dollar decisions.

How will your money be spent on environmental issues?

Find out Friday, Oct. 17, during a Meet The Candidates forum. George Johnson (D) and Republican Steve Schuh (R) will debate how to address pollution threats to our rivers and creeks.

This environmental forum will be held in the Woods Memorial Presbyterian Church in Severna Park. The event is co-sponsored by the Severn River Association (SRA) and the Magothy River Association (MRA). SRA President Lee Meadows will moderate the forum.

The candidates will be asked to explain how they would:

- manage growth and limit proliferation of impervious surfaces
- fund stormwater mitigation projects
- use the flush tax to expand septic system upgrades, and
- crack down on illegal clear cutting along river and creek buffer zones.

There will be ample time for the candidates to field questions from the audience.
